

MUKTI

DISHARI

Dishari is a project about women health and hygiene. We deliver sanitary pads to those women who use dirty cloths instead of using pads. Due to this they suffer from various bacterial and fungal infection which are fatally detrimental to their reproductive health.

We have started this awareness Programme from January, 2021.

Location- Patrasayer, Indus, Sonamukhi Block.

Monthly 200 sanitary pads are distributed.



Our team have reached the benchmark of 5000 women.

We have install 3 sanitary napkin vending machine to three local high school.



HAIR DONATION CAMP

Angikar Paribar, dedicated to making a positive impact in the community, organizes Hair Donation Camps. These camps are aimed at collecting hair donations to support cancer patients undergoing chemotherapy, who often experience hair loss as a side effect. The donated hair is used to create wigs, helping to restore the confidence and dignity of those battling the disease. THALASSEMIA PATIENTS HELP

Thalassemia is a genetic blood disorder that affects the body's ability to produce hemoglobin, which is essential for carrying oxygen in the blood. It can result in anemia, fatigue, and other serious health complications.

To raise awareness about thalassemia, we organized several campaigns to educate people about the condition, its symptoms, and the importance of early diagnosis and treatment.

Real life Story- Subhajit, 10 years old brave boy fights against thalassemia. We provided nutritious food every month for last four years. We also look into how smoothly he can continue his studies.

A mother and her two sons of a family are affected with thalassemia. We ensure them that we will provide nutritious food as long as we can. We have been providing food for three and half years.



We have taken care of total 15 thalassemia affected families providing nutritious food, study materials, blood and medicine, so they can live an easy life..



TB PATIENTS HELP

Tuberculosis (TB) patients often face nutritional challenges that can exacerbate their condition and hinder recovery. Addressing this issue, Angikar Paribar has stepped in to provide healthy and nutritious food to those affected by TB. Recognizing the crucial role of a balanced diet in boosting immunity and enhancing the effectiveness of medical treatments, the organization distributes fresh fruits, vegetables, lean proteins, and whole grains. This initiative not only helps in meeting the dietary needs of TB patients but also promotes faster recovery and better overall health outcomes. Through these efforts, we are trying to make a significant impact on the lives of TB patients, offering them hope and a better chance at overcoming the disease.

SNAKE BITE AWARENESS

Snake bite awareness is crucial to prevent and manage snake bites, which can be life-threatening. It is important to understand the characteristics of venomous snakes, their habitats, and behavior to avoid encounters with them. Basic first aid knowledge and immediate medical attention can save lives in case of a snake bite. So, we organized Snake Bite Awareness camp in various villages.

BACK TO SCHOOL DRIVE



COVID RESPONSE

Our activities during Covid & Natural Disaster



PEOPLE'S KITCHEN

In the first and second phase of the Covid situation, We, Angikar Paribar stood by the unemployed and migrant workers through the People's kitchens. We served cooked food door to door and also served Covid positive patients. Our first People's Kitchen (20th April – 9th May, 2020) continued for **20 days** and our second kitchen (22nd May- 15th Jun, 2021) continued for **25 days**.



11,031 peoples were helped during People's Kitchen in our area



CHILDREN KITCHEN

Everyone is hoping that everything will be the same again. School and college have been closed for a long time. So, in this time we came forward thinking about those kids who have been deprived of mid-day meal for about 90 days and more because of the current situation. Some kids are suffering from malnutrition. So we think that we can give them some nutritious food. Then we started Children's Kitchen for **10 days**.



Total 575 children got their meal through this project in our area.



RATIONING

Although the present state and central government cooperated with rice and wheat, the necessary arrangements for vegetables and shops were neglected in the Covid situation. We stood by many needy people through the Rationing project. Free ration items were delivered to this needy families.



We helped total 584 families in our area.



AREA SANITIZATION

Area sanitization refers to the process of cleaning and disinfecting a particular area or space to reduce or eliminate the presence of harmful microorganisms such as viruses, bacteria, and fungi. This process is particularly important during the Covid-19 pandemic to prevent the spread of the virus. We sanitized our local market and other shops every day during the pandemic.



We also distributed 25000 masks during the village festivals



DISASTER MANAGEMENT

After Aamphan and Yaash hit West Bengal, many families were homeless. Here in our area, the disaster didn't come in that way. Still some families were in really danger. Their only house was rubbed. Some families have had a hard time getting their homes under water. Angikar Paribar have reached out to them to avoid this natural disaster. Some families were evacuated. We provided them some dry foods and tripals.



We helped 46 families providing them dry food and tripals.


